Sightseeing in Saigon (4 hours)

A vibrant metropolis, Saigon teems with energy, activity and motion. Everywhere you look, you see the convergence of traditional and modern life. Begin the trip into modern history with a tour of the Reunification Palace. Formerly the Independence Palace of the South Vietnamese president, this 60s style building was famously stormed by tanks on April 30, 1975 signifying the fall of South Vietnam. It has been preserved in its original state, and the original tanks remain on display near the entrance gates.

Afterwards, drive to the historic center to visit the Emperor of Jade Pagoda, one of Saigon's most interesting pagodas. Proceed to pay a quick visit to the neo-Romanesque Notre Dame Cathedral and the Central Post Office. Pass by the classic European-style landmarks such as the ornate City Hall (Hotel De Ville), the old Opera House (both may only be viewed from the outside). Finally, end up at the central Ben Thanh Market, where vendors display a vast array of goods and handicrafts, appealing to every taste.

Terms & Conditions for Vietnam Coffee Tour.

DEPOSITS:

Deposits of \$1000 per person required to secure names on Flights and Land tour with deposits deducted from final balance but non-refundable once paid.

FINAL BALANCE:

Payable 60 days prior to departure from Australia with our advice being that airfares are prepaid before this date as they can vary regularly with exchange rate, fuel levy and airfares being adjusted daily. Airfare portion will be quoted by Axis travel Centre, based on class, route and dates chosen at the time you wish to make final payment. Axis travel Centre recommends final payment as soon as practical to secure these fares.

NAME CHANGES:

We require exact scanned copies of passport that have a minimum of 6 months life in them upon entering France .Once air tickets are issued, no name, carrier, route or class changes are allowed. The TOUR Package will allow name changes, if substituted with same sex person in same rooming configuration @ \$330 per person change if made before final balance is paid. After Tour balance is paid, no name changes will be allowed or refunds allowed.

CANCELLATION:

Deposits are non-refundable once paid; hence a quality travel insurance policy is essential. Axis travel Centre can provide various options and will issue these for the Group participants to suit needs. Airfares in each class have different conditions, which are as below:

AIRFARE, CRUISE AND ALL TRAVEL COMPONENT OVERRIDING CONDITIONS:

Unless otherwise advised by us in writing, no refunds will be made for unused services or un-availed tickets issued. Amendment, reissue and cancellation fees are usually imposed by Airlines, Suppliers, Hotels, Cruise Companies, Car rental, Travel Insurance and other services, so please accept our advice and obtain the best quality Travel Insurance to protect your important investments. Not all Travel insurances are the same!

Airfares must be paid in full to guarantee fares listed. Once paid, no increases will be payable unless forced by the decree of Governments or Airlines direct, exemplified via possible Security surcharges that can be imposed worldwide at Government, Airport or Airline discretion. Unless otherwise noted by us in writing to you, you can travel on Singapore Airlines into Asia and depart from any other major Singapore Airlines city if you wish, by requesting same from Axis Travel Centre in advance before tickets issued with usually no extra costs as flights depart from Hanoi, Hong Kong, Siem Reap, Phnom Penh and other destinations.

All Singapore Airlines special group air tickets will allow Economy air ticket date changes allowed @ \$330 per date change if same seat class is available and conditions allow this to happen, but be advised that many lower fare classes have limited availability or disallow changes, so changes may not be possible or allowed. Premium Economy and Business class date changes allowed @ \$220 per date change if same seats are available.

Axis Travel staff are trained in these complex rules and regulation areas that may be governed by Airline, Airport, Government and external Internal laws and other regulatory bodies. No credit, refunds or exchanges on any air ticket can be made by us, unless advised by us in writing.

Economy class air tickets are 50% refundable once paid but no sector flown. They are 100% non-refundable once first sector flown.

Premium Economy Class air tickets are 30% refundable once paid but no sector flown. They are 100% non-refundable once first sector flown.

Business Class air tickets are 20% refundable once paid but no sector flown. They are 100% non-refundable once first sector flown. Some Business Class, Premium economy class and First class tickets can be more flexible and lenient with conditions, and we will advise you of this if it is indeed the case. No traveller name, carrier, route or class changes are allowed once tickets are issued hence exact names as per Passports re required by Axis Travel Centre and each Airline.

VISA:

A Visa is required to enter VIETNAM on a valid Australian and New Zealand passports. In each case, Axis Travel Centre will check and advise you.

STOPOVERS: Singapore Airlines will allow stopovers on either forward or return journey. We suggest to at least arrive in HO CHI MINH CITY with the group to ensure a tour debrief there and meet the group...

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Axis Travel Centre is our authorized Travel agency and are also authorized to advise and issue appropriate travel insurance coverage's. Please do not rely upon the purported "free credit card" coverage's or inferior products as Emergencies and After hours assistances must be of the highest quality with English speaking Australian based staff with proven track records. If travel insurance is taken externally Axis Travel Centre cannot assist effectively in emergencies or claims and applies extra fees and charges should such assistance or completion of claims be required.

TOUR COST:

We cannot control exchange rates, but we will NOT increase rates if the AUD to USD\$ does not vary beyond 3% as of rates eff July 20th 2017. If this occurs either against you or in your favour we will adjust rates accordingly. Full payment of Air and land (Tour Package cost) at any time by you will guarantee all costs against any increases whatsoever.

MONIES PAYABLE:

Axis Travel Centre holds all monies in a separate Client Trust account and is full members of IATA (International Air Transport Association), AFTA (Australian Federation of Travel Agents), Cruiseco and other Industry accreditations.

All monies paid will only be dispersed by us on your behalf once cleared .Visa, MasterCard and Amex cards used will incur a 2.2% surcharge, with accumulation of Frequent - Flyer points in many cases and an extended credit period.
